Would allow the state legislature to amend and change a referendum or initiative enacted by the people of Arizona if the measure is found to be unconstitutional or illegal. <b>Vote YES on Prop 128!</b>		
<b>YES on Prop 129</b>	Initiative Transparency	YES <input checked="" type="radio"/> NO <input type="radio"/>
Will amend the state constitution to limit initiatives to a single subject and subject must be expressed in the title of the initiative measure. <b>Vote YES on Prop 129!</b>		
<b>YES on Prop 131</b>	Lieutenant Governor Amendment	YES <input checked="" type="radio"/> NO <input type="radio"/>
Will amend the state constitution to create a new Office of the Lieutenant Governor to be elected jointly with the Governor beginning in 2026 and to replace the Secretary of State as to be first in the line of succession in the vacancy of the Governor. <b>Vote YES on Prop 131!</b>

Will amend the state constitution to require 60% of votes cast to approve an initiative or referendum that enacts a tax. <b>Vote YES on Prop 132!</b>

Reforms how certain classes of debt can be collected and pursued. <b>Vote NO on Prop 209!</b>

Would create a new tax for certain business activities and require new regulations for some businesses. <b>Vote NO on Prop 211!</b>

Would allow non-citizens to receive taxpayer subsidized in-state tuition. These students may have entered the country illegally and/or not have current legal status. <b>Vote NO on Prop 308!</b>

Would require a photo ID before being issued a ballot at an in-person voting location. Would require additional identifying information of a voter for early ballot affidavits. <b>Vote YES on Prop 309!</b>

Will increase the state sales tax for 20 years to fund government districts that already receive local taxpayer funds. <b>Vote NO on Prop 310!</b>
