Would allow the state legislature to amend and change a referendum or initiative enacted by the people of Arizona if the measure is found to be unconstitutional or illegal. Vote YES on Prop 128!

Will amend the state constitution to limit initiatives to a single subject and subject must be expressed in the title of the initiative measure. Vote YES on Prop 129!

Will amend the state constitution to create a new Office of the Lieutenant Governor to be elected jointly with the Governor beginning in 2026 and to replace the Secretary of State as to be first in the line of succession in the vacancy of the Governor. Vote YES on Prop 131!
