**SUBJECT:** Special Session

I hope you have had a restful few weeks. As you know, the Governor has called a special session commencing on Wednesday, July 1, 2009, to cover the following issues: (1) the Sunset scheduling bill; (2) the authorization and appropriation of Proposition 12 transportation bonds and creation of the Texas Transportation Revolving Fund; and (3) the extension of certain specific comprehensive development agreements (CDA) to build roads.

Tomorrow, three House bills will be pre-filed which correspond to the Governor's Proclamation ("call"). On Wednesday, July 1st, the House will convene at 10:00 a.m. and refer bills to the appropriate committees for public hearings. It is my expectation that we will have a calendar for consideration as early as Thursday, July 2nd. If it is the will of the members to do so, we could conclude our business by Friday, July 3rd.
